



HOUSING HAS BECOME A BIG PROBLEM AS MANY FAMILIES WERE EVICTED FROM THEIR HOMES AND THEIR SHELTERS VANDELIZED AND BURNT DOWN DURING THE RIOTS. PTOPERTY WORTH BILLIONS OF SHILLINGS WERE LOST.



DURING THE MAYHEM, FAMILIES HAD TO MOVE AND CAMP IN VARIOUS CENTRES IN SEARCH OF BASIC COMMODITIES AND SECURITY.



AS CAN BE SEEN, FOR THOSE WHO LOST CLOTHING TO FIRE OR ATTACKERS, PROVISION OF CLOTHING AS A BASIC NEED HAS BEEN ALSO GIVEN PRIORITY AMONG OTHER THINGS LIKE FOOD, WATER AND TRANSPORT.



CHILDREN HAVE BEEN THE MOSTLY AFFECTED HAVING BEEN NOT USED TO RASH CONDITIONS AND HAVE THEREFORE BEEN EXPOSED TO DISEASE OUT-BREAK E.G. MALARIA, TYPHOID, AMOEBA, ETC. BASIC COMMODITIES INCLUDING TEMPORARY SHELTERS AND PLAYING KITS ARE NECESSARY



MANY VICTIMS HAVE SUFFERED PSYCHOLOGICAL EFFECTS. ALONG WITH MATERIAL SUPPORT, COUNCELING ALONG WITH PRAYER CENTRES HAVE BEEN ESTABLISHED.



COUNTING THE LOSSES!! THESE MEN LOST THEIR PROPERTY AND ARE THINKING OF THE TOUGH CHALLENGES AHEAD OF THEM.



ARRANGEMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE FOR FEEDING THOSE CAMPING AT DIFFERENT SITES AS CAN BE SEEN IN THE BACKGROUND (LEFT) BUT THERE IS STILL GREAT NEED.



SPENDING ON TRANSPORT HAS BEEN NECESSARY FOR THE EVACUATION OF THESE INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSONS (IDP) TO THEIR RURAL AREAS AND SAFER GROUNDS.



GOSPEL MESSAGES OF HOPE HAVE BEEN GIVEN USING P.A. SYSTEMS AT THESE SITES DUE TO THE LARGE NUMBER OF PEOPLE AS FOOD AND OTHER ARRANGEMENTS ARE MADE IN ORDER TO ENSURE SECURITY, TEMPORARY SHELTER AMONG OTHERS.
